Zephyr Hotel

Designed by the same firm that gave us stylish Hotel Zetta, the Zephyr sports a hip nautical theme filled with games like in-room darts, ping pong, shuffleboard, and an oversized Jenga and Connect Four. Yet the feature that will bring you to your knees is an 11,000 sq. ft. landscaped courtyard brimming with shipping containers, fountains, and fire pits.
